The entire bridal party dressed in white attire; Lauren's 15 bridesmaids chose their own gowns. 1 In addition to slices of the Sylvia Weinstock-designed wedding cake (sylviaweinstock .com), guests could also help themselves to an ice cream sundae bar. O Place settings featured ornate crystal, china, lace napkins, and silver water goblets. "Those details gave the reception a rich, old-world feel," says Lauren. @ After dinner, the couple and their quests danced to music by the Libido Band (libido band.net); later, New York-based DJs Alex & Amir (800-357-6695) spun tunes for late-night revelers. 1 The New York-based couple worked with wedding planner Cheryl Clisby (cherylclisbyevents .com) on the wedding details. After cocktail hour on the Ocean Lawn, the couple and their 350 guests moved indoors to the Venetian Ballroom. Tables were covered with satin and lace tablecloths and decorated with arrangements of greenery, flowers, and votive candles. The dinner offerings included filet mignon with polenta, and seared tuna over soba noodles; all catering by The Breakers.
